





#CONECTAKULTURA: Creative Entrepreneurship

The Forums consisted of a series of meetings in Atlixco, Oaxaca and Mexico City to link people and projects to regional creative economy and promote creative cities. More than 70 independent cultural entrepreneurs under 35 years were trained by Conecta Cultura in four main themes: Cultural rights; Gender perspective in cultural and creative projects; National and international public policies, and Digital and artistic laboratories. 
Conecta Cultura was invited by Colomtures during the International Book Fair in peoples, African descendants and people with disabilities with the attendance of ten Colombian community leaders. The aim of the lectures was to dialogue about the implementation of a cultural rights agenda in Mexico and Colombia to provide visibility to these populations, helping them to strengthen the fight against racism and discrimination in both countries and to promote the exchange of experiences.



Community Development Project in the Sierra

Conecta Cultura was selected by the Canadian energy company TransCanada to design and implement a community development plan for five indigenous communities in the Sierra Tarahumara in the Mexican state of Chihuahua. Conecta Cultura was responsible for creating a working methodology, the execution of a community plan and the training of TransCanada staff to establish a respectful intercultural dialogue between the company and the communities. As a result of the project, Conecta Cultura held 20 training workshops and produced nine publications in English, Spanish and Rarámuri (local indigenous language) on TransCanada's social investment in Chihuahua, and organized the first Rarámuri Cultural Meeting in the region with more than 1,200
